Introduction _____

New Solenoid Valves have been released for the engine brake models listed above. The new Solenoid valves incorporate new design features for improved alignment and better retention of the upper seal. The inside diameter of upper seal P/N 001081 has also changed. This new revision seal can be identified by a yellow stripe.

Impact

The new style solenoid valves can be used as the replacement part whenever a solenoid valve failure occurs. They are direct replacements for the previous solenoid valves. The upper seal shoulder has changed and care should be taken to ensure that the new seal with the yellow stripe is used with the new solenoid.

New style solenoid valves can be identified by the revision level as shown in the table below.




