SUBJECT: IDENTIFYING AN MGM PRODUCT

All MGM brake actuators are easily identified by the part number and the MGM logo. The MGM seven digit part number should be found on the product identification tag. Instructions for locating this tag can be found in the MGM Technical Bulletin, "Product Identification Plate". The MGM logo is found on various parts of the actuators.


Externally:

The logo can always be found on die cast aluminum cylinder cases and center sections. The MGM logo can be found on most stamped steel heads, pressure caps, and mounting non-pressure chambers. In most cases, the logo can be found on the clamp bands and on the plastic end cap. See Figure 1 for examples.

Internally:

The MGM logo can be found on the mounting bolt heads of some models and on piston plates. In most cases, the MGM logo can be found on the diaphragms.


